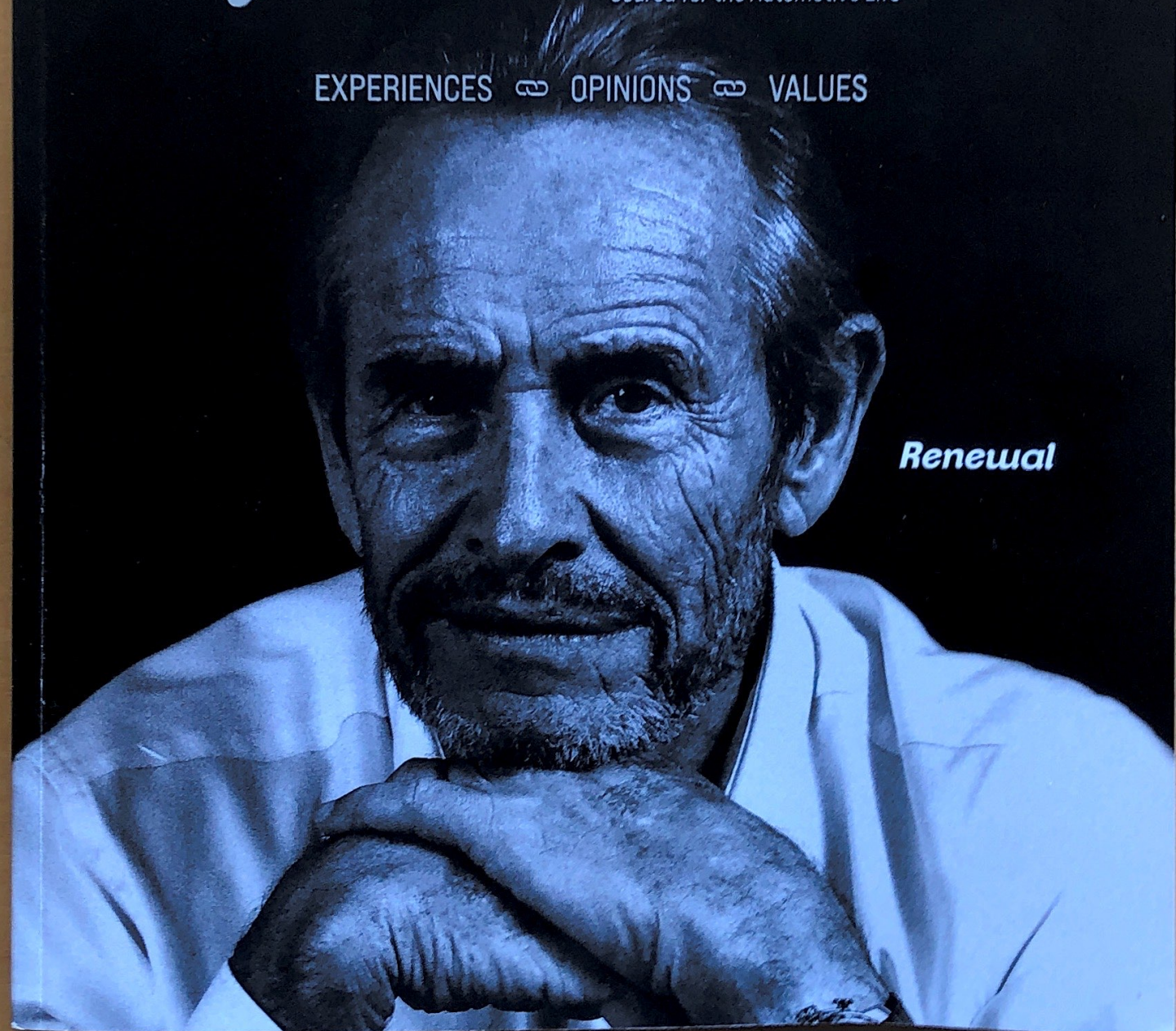

Arizona Auction Week

A lot has happened since then — most importantly Monterey Car Week 2021, where RM Sotheby's, Gooding & Company, Bonhams, Russo and Steele and Mecum Auctions all put on successful, exciting live auctions.

So, it's safe to say that it's very likely that the 2022 Arizona Auction Week will happen in most of its usual glory from January 22 through January 30.

- ▶ **Gooding & Company's** auction is scheduled for January 28-29.
